**“New Approaches to Diagnosis and Treatment of Dry
Eye”**

Synopsis: Dry eye is an exciting field, with new technology available not only for the diagnosis and management of existing dry eye sufferers, but also to identify those at risk for developing dry eye disease.

Since the eye is only able to exhibit a finite number of responses to a variety of insults, signs and symptoms of many disease states can overlap making proper diagnosis and management challenging. Remaining current with new technology is one way to help identify patients who might benefit from early intervention, accurately diagnose those with an existing dry eye condition, and offer specific therapeutic intervention. Dr. Anita Ticak received her combined O.D./M.S. degrees from Ohio State College of Optometry (OSU) in 2008 and completed a Residency in Cornea and Contact Lens at the University of Houston College of Optometry the following year. Currently, she is a Clinical Assistant Professor devoting her time between didactic clinical teaching in the Cornea Contact Lens Service and the Visual Optics Institute. She currently is performing research with Dr. Ray Applegate on wave front guided correction with large diameter scleral contact lenses. Dr. Ticak is devoted to serving the community outside UHCO and works in a private practice on the weekends. She is the Co-Director/Co-Founder of the Dry Eye Center at the University Eye Institute. She is certified in Texas as an Optometric therapeutic and Glaucoma Specialist and is a fellow of the American Academy of Optometry. Dr. Ticak is an appointed member of the faculty liaison committee to the American Optometric Association. Her primary interests include specialty contact lens fitting and the treatment of anterior segment disease with an emphasis on Ocular Surface and Dry Eye Disease.

Lucy E. Kehinde, Ph.D., O.D.

Dr. Lucy Kehinde earned her Ph.D. in Vision Sciences in 2009 and O.D. Degree in 2013 from the University of Alabama at Birmingham School of Optometry in Birmingham, AL. Her research was in tear film biochemistry and research was focused on changes in tear physiology in response to contact lens wear. Following the professional program, she completed a Primary Care residency with an emphasis in cornea and contact lens in 2014 at Indiana University School of Optometry in Bloomington, IN.

After working in private and commercial practice settings, Dr. Kehinde joined the faculty at University of Houston College of Optometry as Assistant Clinical Professor in 2015, where she serves as an attending in Family Practice Service and Dry Eye Center, a clinical laboratory instructor, and lecturer in didactic courses. She is also an investigator for clinical contact lens and pharmaceutical trials in The Ocular Surface Institute and is heavily involved in community outreach through vision screenings in the Houston metropolitan area.
