“Use of Electrodiagnostics in Unexplained Vision Loss”

Synopsis: This course will review electrodiagnostic testing and present unexplained vision loss through a series of interesting cases all referred into an Electrodiagnostic clinic. Dr. Harrison will discuss the different options for testing in those patients with reduced visual acuity or field defects and essentially normal optometric exams. She will review electrodiagnosis and discuss the many reasons for medically unexplained vision loss.
