# “Innovations in Eye Care: 2020 and Beyond”

**Synopsis** – The first portion of the lecture will focus on innovative ophthalmic pharmaceutical agents and their usage in treating neurotrophic keratitis, glaucoma and presbyopia. The remainder of the lecture will discuss LASIK topography-guided laser ablation treatment options. Contoura laser vision correction provides the highest FDA approved quality of vision and opportunity to achieve 20/15 postoperatively. In 2019 we began to utilize Phorcides treatment software to compile the vector analysis of corneal aberrations, manifest refraction, anterior surface astigmatism, and posterior surface astigmatism, all contributing to the final Contoura treatment planning. **2 hour D/T CE**
